The Polish Federation of Valuers' Associations (PFVA) and The European Group of Valuers' Associations (TEGOVA) have the pleasure of organising a European Valuation Conference in Warsaw on 16th June 2023. During the morning session eminent speakers will explore the role of the expert valuation witness in compensation disputes before international arbitration tribunals. This is a timely topic given the likely proliferation of compensation claims for war damage to properties in Ukraine.

The programme will include a staged international tribunal hearing to demonstrate what an expert witness can expect in giving valuation evidence. Experienced expert witnesses instructed by each side to an imagined compensation dispute will be called to present their valuations before a tribunal of distinguished professionals. Top advocates on behalf of the opposing parties will cross-examine the experts and the tribunal will deliver its decision at the end of the conference.

The afternoon session will focus on trending topics in valuation including European Green Deal impacts on property values and radical changes to the Capital Requirements Regulation introducing the concept of a prudently conservative valuation and buttressing restrictions on the use of automated valuation models.
